Don't Forget

Without these little gems it might not be the amazing weekend it should be.

- Your ticket
- EFTPOS and/or credit card for emergencies
- Spending money (for food and booze)
- Camera (batteries and film/memory)
- Sunglasses + spare set for the ones you lose ☺

Clothing

Areas away from the coast can experience warm days and cold nights so be prepared. A 4 degree night in a tent might see you needing a little more than just your trusty uggies.

- Fleece or Woolen Jumper
- Poncho (no umbrellas as they may limit viewing and cause injuries in crowds)
- Warm socks (wool is best)
- Good Footwear (it may get muddy)
- Thermals if you feel the cold
- Bathers/Board Shorts
- Broad Brimmed hat for sun protection

Toiletries

Yes... even for the boys.

- Toothbrush/Paste and 1 spare roll toilet paper
- Towel (we have fast drying compact ones called TekTowels)
- Deodorant, especially for the boys.
- Mesh bag for dirty laundry
- Soap (we suggest Wilderness Wash, an all purpose, clothing, body, kitchen detergent that is biodegradable)

FirstAid

Please consult your GP for any personal medication needs.

- Suncream and lip balm
- Pain relievers
- Insect Repellent
- Band-aids & Condoms

Shelter

A home away from home; be sure to get in early and arrange your tent and mattress with event organizers if you need it.

- Sleeping Bag **comfy** to 5degrees. Be careful that 5 degrees is not the extreme rating on the bag. Our helpful staff are highly trained to help you find the right sleeping bag for your needs.
- Mattress (self inflating Thermarests are light and easy to inflate if not using the ones provided)
- Pillow (to save space a travel pillow or simply a pillow slip with a jumper in it)
- Head Torch (getting around in a tent, reading, cooking... all best done with two hands free)
- Tent (if not using the ones provided)

Cooking & Food

There are common barbeque cooking facilities and pot bellies at the camp sites. You can also use your own containers for takeaway food to save waste. Keep the energy up so you can last into the night.

- Small pot for boiling water
- Hand towel
- Long Life milk
