**REFUNDS/RETURNS/EXCHANGE/CANCELLATION POLICY**

- i) A change in the personal circumstances of the purchaser does not entitle the purchaser to return or exchange the ticket.
- ii) If an event is cancelled due to adverse weather or for any other cause reasonably outside the seller's control there is no right to a refund or exchange and the seller is not obliged to arrange a substitute service, event or performance.
- iii) The seller reserves the right to add, withdraw or substitute artists, vary advertised performance times, seating arrangements and audience capacity, and refuse admission with reasonable cause.
- iv) No warranty is given nor representation made regarding the view of the stage.

**ENTRY, BEHAVIOUR and AGE POLICY**

- i) Any item deemed to be dangerous, hazardous, intimidating or offensive to patrons will not be allowed into the event. This will include but is not limited to items such as knives, pineapples, boats, spears, crocodiles, glass, gang colours, hippy drums, steel toecaps, umbrellas and animals.
- ii) The Wave Rock Weekender is a camping event, so reasonable amounts of camping equipment are permitted. Try not to bring unnecessary stuff.
- iii) The seller reserves the right to conduct body and bag searches of all ticket holders.
- iv) Any patron engaging in behavior deemed to be dangerous, hazardous, intimidating or offensive to other patrons will be ejected from all event areas immediately with no right to refund or exchange. This will include but is not limited to running, throwing objects; aggression; and crowd surfing.
- v) This ticket is sold subject to the conditions on this ticket and any additional conditions displayed at the entry to the event.
